## **Application for Admission Instructions**

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Complete the application in its entirety. Please be sure to either type or clearly print in ink.
- Sign the completed application at the bottom of the last page.
- Enclose the \$50 non-refundable application fee. Checks should be made payable to King's College. (if applying on-line, no application fee is required. kings.edu/admissions/applying to kings)
- Send your official high school transcript, and if Transfer admit status, request official college/university transcript as well.
- Assessment scores are required for admission consideration. Decide whether you will submit official SAT, TOEFL or IELTS scores and have them sent to the Office of Admission.
