NOTES: A student who declares the Theology major after having taken THEO 153 may substitute that course for either THEO 151 or 152 with the permission of the department chair. A student taking Theology as a second major is exempt from two of the free electives and thus can complete the major with only 9 courses ( 27 credits) and can choose any one free elective.

## General Information:

A student must earn a minimum of 120 credit hours to be awarded the baccalaureate degree. The number of credit hours required for graduation may be higher in certain major programs or if the student elects to pursue a second major. Beyond the requirements of the Core Curriculum and of a student's chosen major program, the balances of the credit hours required for graduation are "free electives."

## Suggested Sequence

A suggested course sequence of degree requirements is listed below. Refer to the college catalog for course titles, descriptions, and prerequisites. Always consult your Academic Advisor when planning and scheduling your classes.


NOTE: Because THEO 350 and THEO 450 are offered every other year, some students will take THEO 350 and THEO 450 in their third year and the THEO Seminars in their fourth year, while other will take the THEO Seminars in their third year and THEO 350 and THEO 450 in their fourth year.

${ }^{2}$ Course may satisfy both a Major and a Core requirement. Students majoring in Theology are required to take THEO 151, THEO 152, and THEO 160 or THEO 164.
