MINOR CONCENTRATION

A minor concentration requires a minimum of six courses, representing at least eighteen credits, in the minor field of study. In addition, a department may add academic prerequisites or requirements in related fields, but the total will not exceed 60% of the department's major program requirements. Minor requirements are listed under departmental entries. In order to complete requirements for a minor, the student must take the majority of credits in the minor field at King's. Minor areas of concentration (minors) are permitted, but not required.

Monitoring of student progress in pursuing a minor in **Education** is necessary to enhance the student learning experience. Therefore, a written declaration must be submitted by the student to the Registrar.

Minor Requirements <i>(6 courses – 18 credits)</i>	Credits
<p>Students seeking a minor in Education must complete six 3-credit courses, at least one of which is at the 300-level or higher, selected in consultation with the Education Department Chair. Both EDUC and EDST courses are eligible to count towards the minor.</p> <p><i>NOTE: for EDUC prefixed courses numbered 300 or higher, students would need to pass the Basic Skills tests to enroll due to state regulations.</i></p>	18
