## SPANISH

Minor Concentration
A minor concentration requires a minimum of six courses, representing at least eighteen credits, in the minor field of study. In addition, a department may add academic prerequisites or requirements in related fields, but the total will not exceed $60 \%$ of the department's major program requirements. Minor requirements are listed under departmental entries. In order to complete requirements for a minor, the student must take the majority of credits in the minor field at King's. Minor areas of concentration (minors) are permitted, but not required.

Monitoring of student progress in pursuing a minor in Spanish is necessary to enhance the student learning experience. Therefore, a written declaration must be submitted by the student to the Registrar.

Eighteen (18) credits of courses from SPAN 114 through SPAN 480

Courses must be taken in the same language
*Students are placed in language courses according to their previous experience and placement test results. Students placed in SPAN 111 through SPAN 113 will need to complete between 1-3 semesters of Spanish before they are eligible to take SPAN 114. These courses do not count towards the minor but will count as electives towards graduation.*
